The present writ petition has been filed in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent authorities not to disturb the *Jalkar* settlement in favour of the petitioners earlier since 01.07.2017 to 30.06.2018 and further prayer has been made to take legal actions against the private respondents who have disturb the peaceful possession over the *Jalkar* during the period of settlement of the pond.
