ORAL ORDER

3 25-07-2025 The present petition has been filed for restoration of a writ petition bearing CWJC No.1606 of 2017, which has stood dismissed on account of non-prosecution by an order dated 12.12.2024.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since due to inadvertence, the case could not be marked in the daily cause-list, the counsel for the petitioner could not appear



in the Court when the case was called out for hearing, hence, the aforesaid petition was dismissed on account of non-prosecution, thus a sympathetic view be taken and the aforesaid writ petition be restored to its original file.

3. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner as also considering the averments made in the present petition, I deem it fit and proper to restore the aforesaid writ petition bearing CWJC No. 1606 of 2017 to its original file.
