APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Harsidhi P.S. Case No. 378 of 2024 registered for the offence
punishable under Sections 310(2) of the BNS.

3. As per the prosecution case, unknown criminals
looted Rs. 7,98,000/- from the branch of finance company on
gun point.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. The name
of the petitioner has surfaced in the self-inculpatory statement of
the co-accused from whom the recovery has been made. The
petitioner is in jail since 19.10.2024.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State opposes the



prayer for regular bail of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and submissions of learned counsel for the parties, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, the present bail application stands dismissed.
