The petitioner, who is a Panchayat Teacher, has filed this writ petition challenging the Memo No. 1197 dated 10.11.2022 issued by the Block Development Officer-cum-Executive Officer, Narpatganj, District-Araria, whereby, the petitioner has been transferred from Upgraded Middle School, Jharkaha to Upgraded Middle School, Balua.
