2. The present petition has been preferred for the grant of following relief:

(i) for directing the respondent 1<sup>st</sup> party to prevent/stop the respondent 2<sup>nd</sup> party from illegally taking possession of 20 decimal of private land of the petitioners detailed below- Mauza Hirni, Anchal-Kusheshwar Sthan, District-Darbhanga.
