ORAL ORDER

3 13-05-2025 Heard Mr. Sanjay Kumar Mishra, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners and Mr. Harendra Prasad, learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection with Silao P.S. Case No. 316 of 2024 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 126 (2), 115(2), 117(2), 74, 109, 351(2), 352 and 3(5) of the BNS, 2023.

3. As per the allegation made in the F.I.R., all the accused persons named in the F.I.R. including the petitioners had assaulted the informant and her entire family members.



4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they have falsely been implicated in the case. The allegation levelled against the petitioners, who are female, is general and omnibus. Specific allegation of assault is against the husband of petitioner nos. 1 and 4 namely Kanhai Chaudhary and Sanotosh Chaudhary respectively. Petitioners are next door neighbour of the informant.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners.

6. Having considered the rival submissions made on behalf of the parties, as well as, the allegation made in the complaint which was converted into F.I.R., the case diary reveals that the specific allegation of assault is against the husband of the petitioner nos. 1 and 4, namely, Kanhai Chaudhary and Santosh Chaudhary and the allegation levelled against the petitioners is general and omnibus, the petitioners, above named, are directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM,

7. The District Court is directed to verify the criminal
antecedent of the petitioners and if it is found that the petitioners
are involved in some other cases as what has been stated in
Para-3 of the bail petition, this order will automatically lose its
force.

8. The bail application stands disposed of.
