2 07-03-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Chandra Bhushan Prasad, learned A.P.P. for the State and Mr. Manish Kumar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the informant.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Haveli Kharagpur P.S. Case No. 234 of 2024, dated 05.07.2024 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 504, 506, 498(A), 494, 420 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code as well as Sections 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

3. Learned A.P.P., at the outset, submits that the offences for which the instant FIR has been instituted against the petitioner carry punishment of seven years and less.

4. The said submission of the learned A.P.P. is not disputed by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and the informant.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that



investigation in the case against the petitioner is still continuing but then petitioner has not been issued notice under Section 41(A) of the Cr.P.C., on which learned A.P.P. submits that the case be disposed of in terms of the order dated 13.02.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 3536 of 2024 (Naushad Ansari Vs. The State of Bihar).

6. In view of the submissions made by the learned A.P.P., the anticipatory bail application is disposed of in terms of the order dated 13.02.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 3536 of 2024.

7. The petitioner would be at liberty to file a representation before the concerned Superintendent of Police and the Investigating Officer of the case within a period of three weeks from today with a web copy of the order dated 13.02.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 3536 of 2024 and the concerned Superintendent of Police shall ensure that the Investigating Officer of the case strictly adheres to the direction contained in the said order dated 13.02.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 3536 of 2024.
