2. Recently Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **State of Madhya Pradesh vs. Ramkumar Chaudhary** decided in **[SLP (C) Diary No.48636 of 2024]** on November 29, 2024 elaborately considered belated litigation filed on behalf of the State/individuals.

3. In the later judgment in the case of **H. Guruswamy**



& Ors. vs. A. Krishnaiah Since Deceased By Lrs. the Hon'ble Supreme Court even consider delay is required to be explained from the date of judgment/order which is subject matter of appeal.

4. Taking note of the aforementioned decisions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court I.A. 01 of 2021 stands dismissed, resultantly LPA dismissed.
