2 22-03-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered
for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, 15.3 liters of illicit
foreign liquor has been recovered from the house of this
petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case on suspicion. No incriminating material has been recovered
from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has
got no concern with the aforesaid recovery.

5. Learned counsel for the State submits that the
recovery has been made from the house of the petitioner and he



has got two criminal antecedent of similar nature. Therefore, this anticipatory bail petition is not maintainable, in view of Full Bench decision of this Court rendered in the case of ***Ram Vinay Yadav vs. The State of Bihar*** reported in ***2019(2) P.L.J.R. 1089 (F.B.)***.

6. Considering the aforesaid decision of this Court and similar nature of criminal antecedent of petitioner, the anticipatory bail petition is dismissed.
