2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. The petitioner is aggrieved by the order dated 05.12.2024 passed by the learned District Judge-XIII, Patna in Revocation Case No. 2 of 2024 whereby and whereunder the application dated 19.06.2024 filed under Order 7 Rule 11 read



with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure (hereinafter referred to as 'the Code') has been rejected.
