ORAL ORDER

2 21-03-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant
of regular bail in connection with Gurpa P.S. Case No. 04 of 2025
dated 13.01.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a)
of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 800 litres of illicit
country made liquor was recovered from the five motorcycles out
of which 150 litres of illicit country-made liquor was recovered
from the motorcycle allegedly ridden by the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that
the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession



of the petitioner. The petitioner is not the owner of the said vehicle and he has no concern with the alleged recovery. The co-accused person has already been granted regular bail by this court vide order dated 18.03.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 9102 of 2025. The petitioner has one criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 13.01.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Gaya in connection with Gurpa P.S. Case No. 04 of 2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
