3 09-05-2025 The learned counsel for the opposite parties has pointed out that in compliance of the order of this Court dated 19.4.2018, passed in CWJC No. 11494 of 2017, a sum of Rs. 7,04,619/- has already been paid to the petitioner on the head of admitted dues.

2. At this juncture, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that approximately a sum of Rs. 90,000/- is still remaining to be paid, hence the petitioner be granted liberty to



avail such remedies as are otherwise available under the law for redressal of her subsisting grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands disposed off.
