5 23-01-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the respondents.

2. From perusal of Annexure-P/6 appended to the writ application it appears that the degree obtained from Hindi Sahitya Sammelan, Prayag, Allahabad was valid for appointment in 2006 and it was declared invalid w.e.f. 25.08.2008.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of Annexure-P/6, the order of the respondents terminating the petitioner from service is unsustainable, as the petitioner was



appointed in 2005, whereas the respondents took decision to declare the degree obtained from Hindi Sahitya Sammelan, Prayag, Allahabad invalid w.e.f. 25.08.2008.

4. Considering the aforesaid, the writ application is allowed. The petitioner is directed to be reinstated with all consequential benefits.
