2      21-02-2025              Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP  
for the State.

2.      The petitioner seeks bail in connection with  
Turkaulia PS Case No. 106 of 2024 instituted for the offences  
under Sections 272, 273, 34 of IPC and 30(a) and 41(1) of the  
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3.      The prosecution case, in short, is that 52.800 litres  
of liquor was recovered from mango orchard of Mali Bhagat.

4.      Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the  
present case. No incriminating material has been recovered from  
the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has got  
no concern with the alleged recovery of liquor. It is submitted  
that the place of recovery does not belong to the petitioner. It is



further submitted that the name of the petitioner has transpired on secret information. The petitioner is in custody since 04.12.2024 and has go two criminal antecedents. There is no compliance of Section 103 of B.N.S.S. Other co-accused has been granted regular bail by this Court *vide* order dated 08.05.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 35022 of 2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Turkaulia PS Case No. 106 of 2024.
