A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel for the informant.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for
offence under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 406, 504, 506, 120-B
of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
dispute between the parties has already been settled. Petitioner
is in custody since 26.04.2024. Chargesheet has already been
submitted.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of informant
does not dispute the contention made on behalf of petitioner
regarding settlement of dispute between the parties.

6. Considering the fact that dispute has been settled
between the parties and period of custody, let the above named



petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.
10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount
