ORAL ORDER

2 21-03-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners have preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Darihat P.S. Case No. 10/2025 dated 28.01.2025 registered for the offence punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 110 litres of illicit country-made liquor kept in three sacks were recovered from the motorcycle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the



possession of the petitioners. The petitioners are not the owner of the said vehicle. The petitioner no. 2 has clean antecedent whereas the petitioner no. 1 has one antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioners are in custody since 29.10.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioners.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioners above-named, are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Rohtas at Sasaram, in connection with Darihat P.S. Case No. 10/2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
