2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Kuchaikote P.S. Case No. 515 of 2024 registered for the offence under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Amendment Act, 2022.

3. As per the prosecution case, there is recovery of about 36 liters of illicit liquor.

4. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and he has falsely been implicated in this case. He further submits that the petitioner was not caught on the motorcycle on which the recovery of illicit liquor was made.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts, this application is allowed.

7. Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of



his arrest or surrender before the Court below within four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge-IV-cum-Exclusive Special Excise Court No.-II, Gopalganj/concerned Court below in connection with Kuchaikote P.S. Case No. 515 of 2024, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

8. As a condition of this order, the petitioner, after being released on anticipatory bail, is directed to mark his attendance at Kuchaikote Police Station on every Sunday of each month. Any default in appearance at the police station will result in cancellation of bail bonds of the petitioner.

9. As the petitioner claims to have clean antecedent, the Court below, before accepting the bail bonds of the petitioner is directed to verify the antecedent of the petitioner. If the petitioner is found to be involved in any other case then the bail bonds of the petitioner shall not be accepted.
