2 21-03-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offence punishable under Section 30 (a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, 21.105 liters of illicit
foreign liquor has been recovered from the car of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in this case. No incriminating material has been
recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner.
Petitioner has clean antecedent.

5. Learned counsel for the State submits that the
petitioner is involved in the business of illicit liquor and she



being the registered owner of the car from which the alleged recovery is made.

6. Considering the huge quantity of recovery and petitioner being owner of the vehicle, this pre-arrest bail petition is dismissed.
