ORAL ORDER

3 12-05-2025 Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to
make necessary corrections in paragraph no. 3 of the present
bail application in course of the day.

2. Heard Ms. Suruchi Anand, Advocate learned
counsel for the petitioner and Mrs. Renu Kumari, learned APP
for the State. Perused the case diary.

3. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Bypass
P.S. Case No. 601 of 2024 instituted for the offences under
Sections 338, 336(3), 61(2), 3(5) of the BNS and Section 30(a)
of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

4. The prosecution case, in short, is that total 2965.32
litres of liquor was recovered from truck.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the
petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. No



incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel further submitted that petitioner is not the owner of the vehicle. It is further submitted that petitioner is only the driver of the vehicle in question and had no knowledge regarding the goods loaded in the vehicle. The petitioner is in custody since 21.12.2024 and has one criminal antecedent. There is no compliance of Section 103 of the Bharatiya Nagarika Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

6. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Bypass P.S. Case No. 601 of 2024.
