A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Daudnagar P.S. Case No. 791/2024 dated 14.12.2024 registered for the offence punishable u/s 21 of the N.D.P.S.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 4 gram brown sugar kept in white paper was recovered from the motorcycle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The seized contraband is small quantity. The petitioner is not the owner of the said motorcycle. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has



clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 15.12.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Aurangabad in connection with Daudnagar P.S. Case No. 791/2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
