2. The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection with Chanan P.S. Case No. 109 of 2024 instituted for the offence under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(2), 109, 308(5), 140(1) and 3(5) of the BNS.

3. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with others intercepted the informant, assaulted him with slaps and fists and demanded Rupees Seven Lakhs as the informant has informed the police regarding illegal mining of sand by the petitioner. It is further alleged that in view of Seven Lakh Rupees, the informant was forced to transfer his tractor and that his signature was taken on plain paper.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the



petitioner has submitted that in this case no injury has been caused to anybody and that the alleged tractor has been recovered from possession of Nitish Kumar. There is dispute between the parties regarding some cash. The petitioner has been falsely implicated by creating a story. The petitioner is having no criminal antecedent.

5. In contra, learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioner.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Chanan P.S. Case No. 109 of 2024, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. 1st, Lakhisarai subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
