 appearing on behalf of the petitioners and Mr. Ramesh Chandra,

 learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection with Bakhtiyarpur P.S. Case No. 139 of 2024 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341, 323, 307, 379, 448, 504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the allegation made in the F.I.R., the petitioners are said to have abused and assaulted the informant and his family members. Specific allegation is against co-



accused Arvind Kumar of assaulting on the hand of the informant by means of Kudaal inflicting injury.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submitted that that the petitioners are innocent and they have falsely been implicated in the case due to land dispute. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather general and omnibus. Specific allegation is against co-accused Arvind Kumar.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners.

6. Considering the nature of allegation to be general and omnibus against the petitioners, the petitioners, above named, are directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM-III, Barh, Patna in connection with Bakhtiyarpur P.S. Case No. 139 of 2024, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

7. The District Court is directed to verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioners and if it is found that the petitioners



are involved in some other cases as what has been stated in
Para-3 of the bail petition, this order will automatically lose its
force.

8. The bail application stands disposed of.
