ORAL ORDER

A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Sheohar P.S. Case No. 306 of 2024 dated 01.11.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/s 303(2) of the BNS.

3. As per the prosecution case, the informant's motorcycle was stolen from the door of his house.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is not named in the FIR. The name of the petitioner has sprung up on mere suspicion. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner.



The said recovery was made from the house of the co-accused Subodh Kumar. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 06.11.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Sheohar in connection with Sheohar P.S. Case No. 306 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
