2. Petitioners apprehend arrest in registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 498 (A) of the Indian Penal
Code and 4 of the D. P Act.

3 . It is submitted on behalf of the State that
petitioners have been declared absconder and process of
Section 82 of the Cr.P.C. has been initiated against him to ensure



his appearance in the Court as such petitioners is not entitled to the relief of anticipatory bail (Lavesh v. State (NCT of Delhi) (2012) 8 SCC 730, State of MP v. Pradeep Sharma (2014) 2 SCC 17, Prem Shankar Prasad v. State of Bihar 2021 SCC OnLine SC 955) .

4. Considering the aforesaid development, petition for pre-arrest bail of the petitioners is dismissed as not maintainable .
