ORAL ORDER

5 22-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
APP for the State and learned counsel for the informant.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Ramgarh P.S. Case No. 493 of 2023, instituted for the offences
under Sections 364, 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code and later
on Sections 302, 201 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code was
added.

3. This is the second attempt of the petitioner for bail.
The petitioner has renewed his prayer for grant of regular bail
which was earlier rejected on merit by this Court vide order
dated 13.05.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 21864 of 2024.



4. In compliance of the order dated 03.07.2025, a report dated 29.07.2025 with regard to the present stage of trial has been received. From perusal of the aforesaid report, it appears that the statement of all the accused persons have been recorded under Section 313 of Cr.P.C. on 22. 07.2025 It is further reported that the record is posted on 01.08.2025 for the defence evidence.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 02.01.2024 without any rhymes or reason and the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.

6. Learned APP for the State and learned counsel for the informant have opposed the prayer for grant of bail.

7. There is no new ground to consider the bail petition of the petitioner. From the aforesaid report, it appears that the trial is going on and is at an advance stage.

8. In view of the above, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is again rejected with a direction to the court below to expedite the trial.
