2. The present petition has been preferred for the grant of following relief(s):

*“(i) for issuance of writ in the nature*



*of certiorari to quash the order dated 31.03.2016 passed by the Hon'ble Justice Smt. Mridula Mishra passed in B.L.T. Case No.474 of 2015 whereby and where under the order dated 03.02.2015 passed by learned Divisional Commissioner Tirhut Division, Muzaffarpur passed in Land Ceiling Revision Case no.138 of 2010 has been uphold.*

*(ii) for quashing of order dated 03.02.2015 passed by the Learned Divisional Commissioner, Tirhut Division, Muzaffarpur, passed in Land Ceiling Revision Case No. 138 of 2010, whereby and where under, the Land Ceiling Revision of the respondent no. 2 has been allowed against the petitioner and the orders dated 16.10.2008 passed by Learned L.R.D.C. East, Muzaffarpur passed in Pre-emption Case No. 17 of 2006-2007, as well as order dated 10.07.2010 passed by Learned Additional Collector, Muzaffarpur passed in Land Ceiling Appeal No. 05 of 2008 has been set-aside.*
