ORAL ORDER

2 19-04-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Bahadurpur P.S. Case No. 213 of 2022 dated 12.07.2022 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Amendment Act and Section 414 of the I.P.C.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 144 litres of illicit foreign liquor was recovered from the room of the co-accused person.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The name of the petitioner has transpired in this case in the confessional statement of the co-accused, Niraj Kumar.



Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has 20 criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 30.10.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Patna in connection with Bahadurpur P.S. Case No. 213 of 2022, with the condition:-

(i) The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bonds of the petitioner are liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
