A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel for the informant.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 109, 118(1), 351, 352(2), (3) of the B.N.S.

3. The petitioner is alleged to have assaulted informant with Khanti. Doctor has found the injury simple in nature. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

4. Learned A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel for the informant opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

5. Considering the nature of injury and clean antecedent, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, let the above named petitioner be



enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. - VI, Bhojpur (Ara) in connection with Khawaspur P.S. Case No. 25 of 2024, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of B.N.S.S., 2023.
