ORAL ORDER

2 02-04-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioners have preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Bikramganj P.S. Case No. 29 of 2025 dated 03.02.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a)(c)(d) and 62 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 348 litres of illicit country-made liquor and liquor making apparatus was recovered from the house of the petitioners.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been



implicated in this case. The name of the petitioners has transpired in this case merely on suspicion. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners. The petitioners have no concern with the alleged vehicle. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioners are in custody since 04.02.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioners.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioners above-named, are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Rohtas in connection with Bikramganj P.S. Case No. 29 of 2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
