2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 20 (b), (ii), (c) and 23 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

- 3 . As per prosecution case , on the alleged date and time of occurrence , 332 kg of Narcotics (ganja) worth Rs. 66,4000/- was recovered from seized motorcycle . Petitioner happens to be registered owner of the seized motorcycle .

4. It is submitted by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case . No incriminating article has been recovered from conscious possession of this petitioner.



Petitioner claims clean antecedents.

5. On the other hand, learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and submitted that petitioner is involved in the present case and huge quantity of ganja has been recovered from the seized motorcycle of which this petitioner is registered owner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, nature of accusation and fact that huge quantity of ganja has been recovered from the vehicle of which this petitioner happens to be registered owner, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is rejected.
