APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Manjhauriya P.S. Case No. 484 of 2024 dated 29.07.2024 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 103(1), 238 read with Section 3(5) of B.N.S.

3. As per the prosecution case, the informant alleges that a slit dead body of an unknown woman was found lying in a plastic bag near canal and later, it came to light that it was the dead body of the daughter of the co-accused, Virendra Sah.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in



this case. The petitioner is not named in the FIR. The name of the petitioner was surfaced during the course of investigation. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner rather the specific allegation is against the co-accused, Golu Kumar, Vicky Sah and Virendra Sah. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged occurrence. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 01.08.2024. The co-accused, Virendra Sah has already been granted regular bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 09.04.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 86005 of 2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Manjhauliya P.S. Case No. 484 of 2024, with a condition:-

(i) The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date,



failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable
cause, the bail bonds of the petitioner are liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
