2 28-03-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for
grant of regular bail in connection with Cheriya Beriyarpur P.S.
Case No. 220 of 2024 dated 14.12.2024 registered for the
offences punishable u/s 30(a) and 30(d) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Amendment Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 10 litres of illicit
country-made liquor and liquor making apparatus were
recovered from the bathroom in the house of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in
this case. The name of the petitioner has transpired in this case



merely on suspicion. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has three criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 15.12.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Begusarai in connection with Cheriya Beriarpur P.S. Case No. 220 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
