ORAL ORDER

2 02-04-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Parasbigha P.S. Case No. 256 of 2024 dated 19.11.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 8/20(b) (ii)B of the N.D.P.S. Act, Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act and Section 25(1-B)(a), 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, 3.500 Kg. ganja, 65 litres of illicit country made liquor, Rs. 32,000/- in cash, one country made gun and a pistol were recovered from the house of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted



that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Learned counsel has further submitted that the seized contraband is less than the commercial quantity. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has four criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 20.11.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Jehanabad in connection with Parasbigha P.S. Case No. 256 of 2024 with the condition :-

(i) The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

(ii) If the petitioner is found involved in similar nature of offence in future, the prosecution will be at liberty to



move for cancellation of his bail bonds.

7. The application stands allowed.
