ORAL ORDER

- 6 25-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.
2. Petitioners apprehend arrest in a case registered for
the offence punishable under sections 420, 406/34 of the Indian
Penal Code.
3. As per the prosecution case, on being requested,
informant gave Rs. 1.80 lacs to petitioner no.1 on different dates
for construction of house on the assurance that he would return
the same in four to five months. Later on, petitioners refused to
return the money to the informant.
4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners
submits that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been
implicated in this case. Petitioners never received any amount in
their bank account from opposite party no.2. Petitioners claim
clean antecedent.
5. Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer
for bail. He submits that petitioners, who are father and son



respectively, are named in the FIR with direct and specific allegation that they cheated Rs. 1.80 lacs from opposite party no.2. From perusal of records, it appears that opposite party no.2 has made part payment of aforesaid amount in the bank account of petitioner no.1, who happens to be son of petitioner no.1. Petitioner no.1 has got criminal antecedent.

6. Considering the fact that there is direct and specific allegation of cheating against these petitioners, their prayer for bail is rejected.
