ORAL ORDER

2 02-04-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners have preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Garkha P.S. Case No. 25/2025 dated 09.01.2025 registered for the offence punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 390 litres of illicit country-made liquor was recovered from the four motorcycles out of which 100 litres of illicit country-made liquor was recovered from the motorcycle of the petitioner no. 1 and 90 litres of illicit country-made liquor was recovered from the motorcycle of the petitioner no. 2.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners. The petitioners have no concern with the alleged recovery. As per para. 7 of the bail petition, the petitioners are not the owner of the said motorcycles. The petitioners have clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioners are in custody since 10.01.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioners.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioners above-named, are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Saran at Chapra, in connection with Garkha P.S. Case No. 25/2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
