3 11-04-2025 The present petition has been filed for restoration of a writ petition bearing C.W.J.C. No. 17401 of 2014, which has stood dismissed for want of prosecution vide order dated 05.12.2022.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the aforesaid case could not be marked in the daily cause list on 05.12.2022, resulting in the counsel being
