3 14-07-2025 At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners seek
permission to withdraw the pre-arrest bail petition of petitioner
No. 2.

2. Permission is accorded.

3 . This bail petition of petitioner No. 2 is dismissed
as withdrawn .

4. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner No. 1 and
the State .

5 . Petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered



for the offence punishable under sections 109 (1) , 3 (5) of BNS.

6. The prosecution case in brief, is that informant namely Priyansh Kumar alleged that when he was on his way , in the meantime , all the F.I.R. named accused persons along with these petitioners intercepted him and on protest by informant, co -accused MaheshKumar fired bullet upon his right leg and thereafter this petitioner also fired upon him but somehow , he managed to escape .

7. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that specific accusation of causing fire arm injury is against co-accused Mahesh Kumar. Petitioner has not caused any injury, though alleged to have fired upon informant.

8 . Learned counsel for the State opposed the bail petition .

9. Considering the general and omnibus allegation against petitioner No. 1 and other circumstances of the case , in the event of arrest or surrender within eight weeks from today, let the petitioner No. 1 , as named above , be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class Begusarai in connection with
