 appearing on behalf of the petitioners and Mr. Yogendra Kumar,

 learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection with Bakhari P.S. Case No. 472 of 2024 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 25 (1-b)a, 26, 27 and 35 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the allegation made in the F.I.R., three-four unknown miscreants indiscriminately fired upon the informant with an intention to kill him.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent and they



have been falsely implicated in the case due to dirty village politics. F.I.R. is against unknown. Petitioners were not present at the time of alleged occurrence and they have not committed any illegal act. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the possession of the petitioners rather the recovery of empty cartridges was made from the courtyard of the informant.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners.

6. Considering the nature of allegation made against the petitioners and nothing incriminating was recovered from their possession, the petitioners, above named, are directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai in connection with Bakhri P.S. Case No. 472 of 2024, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

7. The District Court is directed to verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioners and if it is found that the petitioners are involved in some other cases as what has been stated in Para-3 of the bail petition, this order will automatically lose its



force.

8. The bail application stands disposed of.
