2 20-03-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Amnour P.S. Case No. 420 of 2024 instituted for the offences
under Sections 317(2), 317(4), 317(5), 338, 336(2), 340(2) of
the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

3. Prosecution case, in short, is that co-accused
Rajnish Kumar has stolen five motorcycles and sold the same to
the other persons including the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that
the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. No
incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious



possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel further submitted that petitioner has purchased the motorcycle in question from the co-accused Rajneesh Kumar. Learned counsel further submitted that petitioner was not aware that the motorcycles in question were stolen property. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 16.12.2024 and has no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as also the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Amnour P.S. Case No. 420 of 2024.
