APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Madhepura P.S. Case No. 430 of 2024 registered for the offence
under Sections 302, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner is
accused of killing the deceased.

4. It has been submitted by the learned counsel for
the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and the main
allegation of assault is against Rupesh Kumar @ Rakesh
Ranjan. The petitioner is in custody since 22.04.2024.

5. Considering the aforesaid facts, this application
is allowed.



6. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Madhepura/concerned Court below in connection with Madhepura P.S. Case No. 430 of 2024.

7. As a condition of this order, the petitioner, after being released on bail is directed to co-operate in the trial either by appearing personally or through his lawyer in the trial Court on each and every date fixed by the trial Court. Non-compliance of the condition will result in cancellation of the bail bonds of the petitioner.
