2 03-04-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

2. Petitioners apprehend arrest in case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 326(g), 303(2), 352, 351(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.

3. As per prosecution case, on the alleged date and time of occurrence, these petitioners along with 3-4 unknown persons came to the shop of informant and demanded articles by abusing him. Upon protest, the accused persons looted cash of Rs. 62,000/- and set the shop of informant on fire.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have committed no offence.



Allegation against petitioners is general and omnibus.
Petitioners claim clean antecedent.

5. Considering the nature of accusation, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is refused.
