2 09-04-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per prosecution case, 216 liters illicit liquor was recovered from jute bags.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no incriminating material has been recovered from conscious possession of the petitioner and he has been made accused in this case only on suspicion. The bags in question does not belong to the petitioner.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that the petitioner has got three criminal antecedents of similar nature.



6. Considering the criminal antecedents of similar nature, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is refused.
