3 30-04-2025 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, learned APP appearing on behalf of the State and learned counsel for the informant.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 110, 352, 351(2)(3), 303(2) and 3(5) of the B.N.S..

3. As per prosecution case, informant, namely Ved Prakash, alleged that on 13.08.2024 at about 10 AM, while he was returning home on his bike, in the meantime, he was forcibly stopped and brutally assaulted by all the F.I.R. named accused persons, including this petitioner. Petitioner has got 19 criminal antecedents.

4. Considering the specific and direct nature of



accusation and criminal antecedents of the petitioner, the prayer
for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is rejected.
