2 16-04-2025 Heard Mr. Amit Ranjan, learned counsel appearing
on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Syed Mojibur Rahman,
learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection
with Kouwkol P.S. Case No. 09/2025 registered for the
offence(s) punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the allegation made in the FIR, 150 litres of
illicit liquor was recovered from bush.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent and has falsely
been implicated in the present case. Local *Chowkidar* has
disclosed the name of the petitioner, with whom the petitioner
has inimical term. Petitioner has clean antecedent.



5. Learned APP for the State vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail.

6. In the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned District Court within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Excise Judge-2, Nawada in connection with Kouwkol P.S. Case No. 09/2025, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.

7. The learned District Court is directed to verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioner and if it is found that the petitioner is involved in some other cases, as what has been stated in paragraph no.3 of the bail application, this order will automatically lose its force.
