2 18-04-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The instant application for anticipatory bail has been
filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection
with Karakat P.S. Case No. 590 of 2024 instituted for the
offence under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise
Act.

3. The case of the prosecution is that one person fled
away throwing a bag in his hand and that bag contained six
litres of country made liquor. The person who fled away was
identified as the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
has submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no
offence. He has falsely been implicated in this case. He also



submits that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner name has surfaced in the statement of the co-villagers. A statement has been made in para-3 of this petition that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.

5. In contra, learned APP appearing for the State opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioner.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Karakat P.S. Case No. 590 of 2024, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Judge, Excise Court No. 1, Rohtas at Sasaram subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
