ORAL ORDER

A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Benipatti Excise P.S. Case No. 23 of 2025 arising out of G.O. Case No. 188 of 2025 dated 05.02.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 90 litres of illicit Nepali country made liquor was recovered from the two sacks tied on the motorcycle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is not the owner of the said vehicle. The



petitioner is only the driver of the said vehicle and he has no concern with the alleged recovery. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. As per the impugned order dated 21.02.2025, the petitioner is in custody since 06.02.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Madhubani in connection with Benipatti Excise P.S. Case No. 23 of 2025 arising out of G.O. Case No. 188/2025.

7. The application stands allowed
