1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of anticipatory bail apprehending his arrest in connection with Magadh Medical P.S. Case no. 14 of 2025, registered under section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

3. As per the prosecution case, 10 litres of country liquor was recovered from behind the house of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no incriminating article has been recovered either from the petitioner's possession or from his house. The alleged place of recovery does not belong to this petitioner. He has been falsely implicated in the case. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent and undertakes to cooperate in the case/trial.



5. The application for anticipatory bail is opposed by learned A.P.P. for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the allegations against the petitioner in the F.I.R, no incriminating article having been recovered from the petitioner’s possession and especially the petitioner not having any antecedent under the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016, it is directed that the petitioner above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks, be released on anticipatory bail in connection with Magadh Medical P.S. Case no. 14 of 2025 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Exclusive Special Excise Court no-4, Gaya.
