2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Kotwa P.S. Case No. 28 of 2025 dated 24.01.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act and Sections 8, 20b(ii)A of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 42.385 litres of illicit foreign liquor and 455 gms. ganja were recovered from the hut of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that the



petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The seized contraband is less than the small quantity. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 25.01.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Kotwa P.S. Case No. 28 of 2025 with the condition :-

*(i) The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.*

7. The application stands allowed.
