ORAL ORDER

A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Naokothi P.S. Case No. 32 of 2025 dated 15.02.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/s 61(2) of the B.N.S. and Sections 32, 41 and 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act and Section 25(1) (a) of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 134.64 litres of illicit foreign liquor was recovered from the motorcycle which was parked outside of the petitioner's house in the corridor and from the room of the petitioner's house.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. No incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that the petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has three criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 16.02.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Begusarai in connection with Naokothi P.S. Case No. 32 of 2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
