A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Excise P.S. Case No. 143/2025 dated 06.02.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a), 30(c), 30(d) and 36 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 30 litres of illicit country-made liquor, 140 litres of illicit spirit, 500 pieces of 300ml empty bottles, 250 pieces of 180ml empty bottles, 100 pieces caps and empty gallon were recovered near the bank of river.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted



that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The recovery is made from an open place which is accessible to anyone. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 06.02.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Aurangabad, Bihar in connection with Excise P.S. Case No. 143/2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
